Why Are Activities Important?

How to write about skills in your personal statement: The ABC method

Listing your experiences is not enough. It is also important to highlight the skills you have developed and how they are relevant to the course. The ABC method is a way of writing about these experiences in more detail.

Activity: What have you done?

Benefit: What skills have you gained?

Course: How will this prepare you for the course?

Why not try for yourself? We have given an example to help. The student below is applying for Business Studies.

Activity eg *I am the school captain of the football team.*

Benefit eg *This shows I have good communication and team working skills.*

Course eg *This is relevant to Business Studies as being able to communicate effectively is an important skill when working on group projects.*

TOP TIP

Do your research! You can only make an informed choice and show a real understanding of the course and subject area, if you have researched thoroughly.
