

# YCIS History and Network

Providing Qingdao's expatriate community with outstanding quality education across a broad spectrum ranging from childhood to senior secondary education, Yew Chung International School of Qingdao (YCIS Qingdao) has offered a distinctive education programme in a bilingual and multicultural environment since 2006. We are committed to extending opportunities to our students to achieve academic and all-round excellence in lifelong learning.

Located on the scenic coastline of the Shandong Province YCIS Qingdao enjoys this tranquil situation. Our school is easily accessible from popular living areas.

Our programmes and administration integrate uniqueness which is fundamental to the overall operation of the school. Our Chinese and Western Co-Principals co-operate to create a school culture where Eastern and Western values and education models are equally regarded by the whole school community.

YCIS Schools are also located at Hong Kong, Shanghai, Beijing, Chongqing in China and Silicon Valley in the United States, boasting over 10,000 students across all campuses.

### YCIS Network Internal Transfer

All YCIS schools operate under the same educational philosophy, pedagogy, and curriculum. We understand expatriate families sometimes need to be relocated around China and Hong Kong in particular, so we make it very convenient for enrolled students to transfer (not requiring application process or fee) to any school within our network that includes Hong Kong, Shanghai, Beijing, Chongqing, and Qingdao (in China), and Silicon Valley (in the US). Internal transfer students do need to meet the eligibility requirements of the local government, and the receiving school may need to evaluate suitable placement.



## YCIS Education Programme

YCIS's international curriculum is based on the framework and schemes of work from the National Curriculum for England (NCE). The research-based curriculum encourages high standards and ensures continued learning from one year level to the next through graduation. The objective is to develop students' critical and creative thinking skills, both independently and co-operatively. English is the primary language of instruction for our learning programme; however, our international education is quite specialised and implements best practices and methods from education systems worldwide. Our strong Chinese Language and Culture Programme has been developed by YCIS's own research over several decades, and our students are expected to attain a high level of fluency in both oral and written English and Chinese.

YCIS students may sit external examinations for the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) at the end of Year 11. Upon successful completion of IGCSE, students undertake further education in the International Baccalaureated (IB) Diploma Programme in Years 12 and 13.



#### International Recognition

YCIS Qingdao is fully accredited by The Council of International Schools (CIS), and Cambridge International Examinations center (CIE). Furthermore, as an International Baccalaureate World School (IB World School), we are proud to offer the IB Diploma Programme as part of our international curriculum, with the majority of our students earning a bilingual IB diploma. # Early Childhood Education Programme

Starting at age two, the YCIS Early Childhood Education (ECE) Programme provides a well-rounded education for children through the age of five. The specially developed curriculum allows children to discover the joy of learning through a balance of play and structured activities. Our unique international educational programme nurtures each individual child's growth, and fosters their social, emotional, cognitive, physical, creative and spiritual development.

The ECE programme is enriched by our globally recognised Co-Teaching model. In every Kindergarten classroom, one Western and one Chinese teacher act as equal partners to provide all learning and care for the children in a multicultural and bilingual learning environment.

The ECE Programme gives children a strong foundation for their education and develops a set of skills that will prepare them for success and enjoyment in their life-long learning journeys.

After completion of K4, students are carefully supported through the transition into the next phase: Year 1 of the Primary Programme.





# Primary Programme

The Primary Programme at YCIS Qingdao provides a high quality and global-focused education to international students in Qingdao aged 5–11. We have designed our own unique international curriculum, which fulfils the learning criteria of Lower Primary (Years 1–3) and Upper Primary (Years 4–6) of the National Curriculum for England (NCE). The Primary Programme develops a positive learning attitude in every student, fostering inquisitiveness, critical and creative thinking.

Our Co-Teaching model continues throughout the Primary Programme with one Western and one Chinese teacher working as partners in the classroom. As a result, students develop solid linguistic skills in both English and Chinese languages, as well as an open-mind and respect for both cultures. Students' learning is enriched beyond traditional education to include even non-verbal nuances and symbols from both cultures.

Art and music form an integral part of our curriculum, and all Primary students take several art and music lessons a week, including the foundation of our music programme, the violin programme, for all students in Years 1–3.





# Secondary Programme

Students in our Secondary Programme are immersed in a vibrant and stimulating environment for learning and social development. Our competitive academic curriculum is partnered with a wide range of Co-curricular activities, and our highly experienced and dedicated teachers and support staff contribute to the challenging, innovative, and caring learning environment. Sports teams and competitions also provide ready challenges for developing minds and bodies.

#### Years 7-9

The curriculum of the Lower Secondary Programme (Years 7–9) follows the National Curriculum for England's (NCE) learning objectives with some specialist adaptations, including our unique Chinese Language and Culture Programme. As a result of this course of study, students become equipped with solid organisational skills and increased self and environmental awareness. At the end of Year 9, all students sit public examinations administered by the Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) called Checkpoint in Mathematics, English, and the Sciences. These important years fully prepare students both academically and socially for the increasing challenges of the Upper Secondary years to follow.

#### Years 10-11

#### International General Certificate of Secondary Education

In Years 10 and 11 students work towards achieving the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE). This qualification is the most popular international certificate worldwide for this age group and is administered by Cambridge International Examinations (CIE).

Students embark upon a two-year programme of study including possible participation in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) examinations. Students study a combination of required and optional courses. Most students achieve the CIE International Certificate of Education at the conclusion of Year 11.

The required courses are:

- English Language and World Literature or English as an Additional Language
- Chinese Language Mathematics
- Science
   Global Perspectives
   PE

The optional courses include:

- History Economics Music
- Computer Science Art & Design

IGCSE students are recognised internationally for their problem-solving, investigative, independent, and co-operative working skills.

#### Years 12-13

#### International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme is a rigorous pre-university course of study designed to meet the needs of highly motivated Secondary students between the ages of 16–18. This comprehensive two-year programme provides graduates with a qualification which satisfies the requirements of national educational systems around the world, making it the ideal qualification for international students. The International Baccalaureate Organization's (IBO) reputation for assessment also gives IB Diploma holders access to the world's leading universities and the skills required for future success.

# The Components of the IB Diploma Progamme

During the two-year programme, students will follow six subject courses chosen from six subject areas. In addition, all students complete the core activities of the IB Diploma by studying Theory of Knowledge (TOK), writing an Extended Essay (EE), and participating in Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) projects.

### University Guidance Programme

To prepare our students for their journey beyond YCIS, our University Guidance Office (UGO) offers one-to-one college planning support, assists students in compiling the necessary materials required for university and college applications, and helps prepare transcripts and reference letters for students. University and career guidance is also a part of the curriculum for students in Years 10–13, where our University Guidance Counsellors teach courses to help students develop important skills needed to prepare for an independent life beyond high school. As a reflection of our strong academic programme and the value of our UGO programme, YCIS students typically receive multiple offers from a wide range of top and specialised universities around the world.

# Trips & Excursions

At YCIS, we want our students to be forward-thinking and active members of their community, within and beyond our campus walls. Trips and excursions are implemented meaningfully into the curriculum and provide students with external experiences and perspectives, fuelling their holistic development.

#### World Classroom

The World Classroom is a unique programme offered by YCIS to help prepare our students to participate effectively in today's global society. Students from Years 7–10 have opportunities to take their learning outside the classroom by travelling abroad to visit other major world cultures with experienced staff. Projects during the trips provide both an educational and charitable element, such as building a new school in Tanzania, giving students real encounters with diverse cultures.



### **Experiencing China**

The Experiencing China Programme provides opportunities to Secondary students to gain insights into Chinese history and culture by visiting various parts of China. This programme broadens students' understanding of their host country, leads to increased cultural respect and helps bring a sense of meaning and perspective to their life in China.



### **Global Education at YCIS**

**YCIS** offers a true blend of both Eastern and Western cultures, equipping children to be bilingual, global-minded, competitive, appreciative, and caring global citizens. Students are nurtured in a multicultural and bilingual environment with a focus on providing a balanced education in order to help transform them into global-thinking individuals.





#### **Character Education**

One of YCIS's signature calling cards is its commitment to the development of each student's moral code that will help them to make correct choices later in life. From Early Childhood to Upper Secondary, every YCIS student realises the importance of helping others in order to work towards creating a better world. These objectives of our Character Education Programme, emphasised in all daily lessons, weekly assemblies, and other activities beyond the classroom walls, are essential to the YCIS education and the creation of global citizens.

### **Community Service Programme**

YCIS actively participates in a range of charity programmes. The Yew Chung Education Foundation coordinates with all YCIS schools to raise funds for our Seeds of Hope Schools and other local charities. As part of our Secondary Curriculum, students participate in Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) projects, which are designed to raise students' awareness of the needs of their local and global communities.







Two Co-Principals (one Western and one Chinese) and our General Manager make up the School's Senior Leadership Team to provide academic and administrative vision and management to the school. Additionally, in our Primary, equal numbers of fully-qualified Western and Chinese teachers share equal responsibility for the children's learning and development within a collaborative model which enhances cultural appreciation.

### **Combining the Best of Eastern and Western Cultures**

YCIS combines the best of the Eastern and Western cultures by promoting fluency in two major world languages, creating a truly bilingual learning environment, providing courses of study in Eastern and Western philosophies, and nurturing students to be outstanding individuals who respect and value one another's culture.

Whether it's starting to learn about sounds in Kindergarten, developing a foundation in music in Primary, or honing performance and instrumental skills in Secondary, music plays a major role in school life at YCIS. From our unique violin programme for students in Years 1–3 to the many musical performances that happen all year round, not only do children build confidence and presentation skills, they also develop extremely strong instrumental skills and a lifelong appreciation for music. As a result, our graduates matriculate to the top music schools and programmes worldwide.

### Well-Rounded and Balanced Education

Sports are an integral part of students' life at YCIS, and participating in sports activities helps them to develop confidence and face challenges. YCIS Qingdao is developing sports teams and students have the opportunity to participate in a wide range of events through inter-house and inter-school programmes.



### **Art and Artist-in-Residence (AIR)**

Our Artist-in-Residence Programme is a distinct educational opportunity for our students, in which they interact with working artists on campus. In addition to our talented Visual Arts Teachers, our AIR Programme is a source of inspiration for our students, an opportunity for them to learn about the dynamic art scene in China and worldwide, and our AIRs offer our students the chance to develop creatively by learning techniques directly from professional artists. Our AIRs lead various art activities within the school, from cross curricula projects to creating large-scale murals.

Each of our schools employs a Parent Relations Officer to serve families and the school within a social and supportive liaison role.

### Admissions

We welcome parents to learn more about YCIS Qingdao, especially by coming to visit! Campus tours are wonderful opportunities for families to learn more about the YCIS philosophy, curricula, and facilities, as well as a chance to have any questions answered.

YCIS Qingdao upholds a non-discriminatory policy and accepts applications from any eligible student. Review of an application can only begin when all the required documents and the application fee are received. Applications are usually processed within three working days unless additional assessments for placement are required. The School reviews each application carefully to assess the student's academic, linguistic, and social stage of development. For some year levels an assessment test and/or interview may be necessary before admission to ensure proper placement.

We admit students who we believe will benefit positively from the educational programmes we provide at YCIS. In order to be admitted, students must be able to access the regular curriculum without the need for services beyond our learning support and other available programmes and services.

### **Chinese Language and Culture Programme**

Our Chinese Language and Culture Programme is the thriving cornerstone of the globally progressive education we provide, and it helps open doors for our students and fosters their cross-cultural thinking and open-mindedness. Furthermore, in order to develop a deeper understanding of the language, our students also study Chinese culture.

At **YCIS**, students learn to read, write, and speak fluently in Chinese. Our curriculum caters for all ages from Early Childhood Education through Secondary school, and is tailored for both non-native and native speakers. All students in our Primary and Secondary Programmes have a Chinese language lesson for one hour every day, helping them to establish a path toward fluency in just a few years.

In addition to daily language lessons, our students in Years 1–9 take one hour of Chinese culture lessons per week as part of our Chinese Studies Course. The learning topics are diverse, and integrate subjects such as History, Geography, Literature, Art and Music, and Traditional Festivals, adding meaningful context to the Chinese language students are studying in class. The programme places a strong emphasis on today's China and China's culture heritage, and encourages students to embrace and use their learning during their time in China.

# 幼儿教育 课程

### 小学课程

### 一至六年级

青岛耀中国际学校小学部为不同国籍、5至11岁的学生提供高质素及国际化的教育。国际课程根据英格兰国家课程中的初小和高小阶段的学习标准而研发,意在培养学生积极的学习态度、好奇心、批判性和创造性思考能力。

小学部采用独特的双教师合作教学模式,每班配备华籍、外籍教师各一名,共同进行中英文双语合作教学。这种打破传统的教育模式,糅合了中西方文化精髓,不仅使学生精通中英双语,还培养他们尊重不同文化的态度。

### 中学课程

### 十二至十三年级

### 国际文凭课程(IB)


