

上海耀华临港校区世界教室项目于 2016 年 4 月启动了。六至九年级学生在老师的带领下,远赴海外,拓展视野,领略不一样的西方社会文化和人文知识。

今年世界教室的目的地是伦敦,在十天的行程中,学生参观地标"伦敦眼"、欧洲最大的自然历史博物馆、汉普顿宫及伦敦西区。世界教室项目不是普通的海外旅游,学生通过实地考察、团队协作来完成相关的学术报告和作品。学生采访街头艺人,感受伦敦的街头艺术文化,同时探寻在经济全球化的背景下,中国制造的商品遍布全球的意义。同时,学生从不同的角度,带着"世界公民"的身份,以"国际人"的态度向西方国家学习和探索。



We launch our World Classroom programme this April. The destination this year is London. Although many students have already been to the UK, most of the scenery spots are still very attractive to them. This time, they are supposed to visit England with a different angle: as a global citizen with an international attitude. During the trip, the students visit the London Eye, Natural History Museum, Hampton Court, and Covent Garden. Students interview the artists performing on the street and have a taste of the artistic culture. They also witness that products made in China are prevalent all over the world under the influence of globalisation.



The World Classroom programme is an extension of the experiential, project-based learning at the core of the YWIES educational model. It is just one unique experience in the YWIES global education model that allows students to experience major cultures of the world.

#### Searching for Answers about **Dinosaurs**

12 月份, K3B 班学习关于恐龙的知识,为此,我们决定参观自然博物馆。在参观前几天,孩子列出关于恐龙的问题:恐龙骨骼有多大? 牠们怎么消失的?恐龙蛋多大?真的脚印长什么样?

我们带着这些问题来到自然博物馆。当孩子看见最大的恐龙 骨骼——梁龙,都非常吃惊:"哇,哇,看!这么大!"

我们还看了我们学过的所有的恐龙:霸王龙、小盾龙、鹦鹉嘴龙、三角龙、剑龙、甲龙、阿马加龙、蜀龙、梁龙、以及巨大的恐龙蛋。之后,我们去了恐龙公园,当孩子看到模拟的恐龙都非常高兴,看到牠们是怎么走路,发出什么声音,牠们在做什么,牠们吃什么。孩子找到了所有问题的答案后,安心返回学校,坐在一起分享所看所感。

In December, K3B started learning about dinosaurs. We therefore planned to visit Beijing Museum of Natural History. A few days before the visit, the students made a list of questions: how big are dinosaur bones? Why did dinosaurs disappear? How big is a dinosaur egg? How do their footprints look like?

During the visit, we went to see the skeleton of the biggest dinosaur – Diplodocus. The kids were shocked and started to scream and shout, "Wow, wow, look! It is gigantic!"

We also saw all dinosaurs we had learnt: T-Rex, Scutellosaurus, Psittacosaurus, Triceratops, Stegosaurus, Ankylosaurus, Amargasaurus, Shunosaurus and Diplodocus, as well as giant dinosaur eggs. After visiting the museum, we went to the dinosaur park, watching "real" dinosaurs, and learning how they walk, how they make sound and what they eat. After the kids had found all the answers to their questions, we went back to school and had a sharing session.



### 骑行千里助病童

#### 2015 Charity Cycling Aiding Autistic Children



上海耀华骑行社团和健社团协办的慈善骑行在 2015 年 11 月 13 至 16 日顺利举行,为自闭症儿童关爱机构南京爱德儿童发展中心募捐了一万元善款。参加者由上海骑行到南京,为中心筹款,改善中心的学校条件,引发更多人对自闭症儿童的关注。与此同时,号召大家强身健体,并推广绿色环保的出行方式。

为了筹集善款,慈善骑行的同学在耀华的校园集市上练摊儿募集资金;周密的活动计划和服务社会的爱心之举,更得到企业宜信财富的肯定和赞助。

和自闭症儿童近距离接触后,同学感触很深。有同学反思说自己以前在提到自闭症儿童时,会无意中用到一些歧视性话语,这次活动使他对自闭症儿童有了直观的认识,对他的震撼很大,让他开始思考如何更好地从自身的言行做起来关爱这些孩子。

Yew Wah Cycling Club and Key Club organised the Charity Cycling successfully during November 13 to 16, raising RMB 10,000 yuan for Nanjing Aide Children Development Center, an organisation caring for autistic children. The participants cycled from Shanghai to Nanjing, raising fund to improve the center's teaching conditions, and arouse more awareness for autistic children. At the same time, they called for travelling in environmentally friendly ways and keeping fit.

In order to raise fund, the student participants set up their own store at Yew Wah's Business Fair. Their well-thought-out planning and charity spirit even won them the support and donation from CreditEase Wealth Management.

After direct interaction with the autistic children, the students reflected deeply. One club member felt very sorry that he sometimes unconsciously used some discriminatory language when talking about the autistic children. 第三,校方准备的孩子成长档案利用多种方式评价与记录孩 子的学习和发展,并附有照片和班级老师的评语指导,使家 长能够更好地了解孩子并与他们互动!

Teachers and we parents share the same aim of nurturing children – to shape them into persons of integrity and talent. I would like to share some of my thoughts on this topic:

First of all, the school designs some lessons based on a famous quote "Tell me and I will forget; show me and I might remember; involve me and I will understand", which I find very meaningful. The activities in these lessons successfully arouse the children's interests in learning and develop their potential abilities.

Secondly, teachers, adopting Activity Approach, take the children to the kitchen to see how the cooks work, and take the children to fire stations to see how the firefighters work. Letting children learn from their own experiences is a very good way to motivate them to learn.

Thirdly, the school prepares children's portfolios which evaluate and record the development of the children, with photos and teachers' comments. Through the portfolios, parents can learn more about their children's school life and interact better with the

#### YWIES Participates in **Beijing International School Expo**

耀华北京校区占地 119,000 平方米,环境优美,交通便捷。学校采用新型的绝缘外墙及优质德制门窗系统、进口空气净化系统,以保障室内空气质量。校园由美国著名的 FNI 公司设计,遵从以学生为中心的原则,通过整合教学区域来更好地配合不同教学模式,增强空间运用的灵活性、提升学生的积极性及教师的参与度。耀华校园建设的设计环节全面遵循美国绿色建筑协会 LEED 的绿色建筑标准。



Yew Wah International Education School of Beijing (YWIES) participated in Beijing International Education School Expo held by *Jingkids* magazine from January 16–17. More than 500 parents visited YWIES's booth and talked to our superintendent and academic team. Some parents helped their children apply for Kindergarten and Primary for the school year of 2016-2017 on the spot.

The parents enquired about YWIES's curriculum, enrolment requirements, campus environment, etc. YWIES's superintendent said, "There is no other country like China in paying such attention to education. No matter which educational system you choose, the purpose is to educate the whole person. The history of education in China is very long. There is a famous proverb 'It takes 10 years to grow trees, but 100 years to educate people.' The international educational system makes the educational industry in China develop with more diversity. YWIES would like to contribute to education together with the educators in China."

YWIES has an approximate total site area of 119,000 square metres at a convenient location which allows easy access to downtown. The campus buildings use a central air-conditioning and floor heating system, combined with new generation outer wall insulation and a high quality Germany-made door and window system. The classroom building is equipped with an air purification system. The campus design was done by FNI which specialises in the architectural and interior design for international schools all over the world. The design supports 21st century learning, and emphasises the importance of learning community. This provides more flexibility and agility that increase student engagement and teacher involvement. YWIES has also incorporated the green building standard of the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) of the US into our campus design.

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### "耀华地铁"启程了 YWIEK Metro Starts

地铁是上海这座城市必不可少的交通工具之一,中班孩子对地铁很有兴趣,于是,我们开始了专题研习活动——"地铁"。

学校附近就是地铁六号线博兴路站,于是,老师带领幼儿集体参观及乘坐地铁,让孩子感受、体验及深入了解地铁。参访回来后,幼儿对地铁的兴趣更加浓厚了,他们想在学校制作一辆地铁,于是老师就带着孩子开始了深入的"地铁探索之旅"。

老师和孩子经过两个多月一起探究和制作后, "耀华地铁"完工了。孩子请爸爸妈妈参观他们的地铁, 更为 "耀华地铁"举行了剪彩仪式。剪彩后,每位家长扮演乘客和孩子一起玩"地铁站"的角色游戏,爸爸妈妈在体验取钱、买票、安检、刷卡进站的同时,仿佛回到了游戏时代的童年。他们惊讶地发现,在游戏中,孩子能坚守自己的岗位,明确自己的职责,还能顺畅地与小伙伴分工合作。

"地铁"专题研习活动虽然结束了,但是它留给幼儿的学习 热情、深入探究能力、思考和解决问题的能力并没有终止。 我们相信,在以后的专题研习活动中,幼儿一定能够把今次 的经验加以运用。 Metro is an important transport in Shanghai. Our K4 students are very interested in it; we therefore carried out a project to explore the transport system.

The Boxing Road station of Metro line 6 is very close to our kindergarten, so we organised a tour to let our children take the Metro themselves. After the tour, our children wanted to construct a "metro" for the kindergartner. Teachers helped them to know more about the transport with an in-depth metro lesson.

After two months of exploration of and research on the Metro system, finally we "built" our YWIEK Metro and held an opening ceremony with ribbon cutting. On the day of the ceremony, we invited all the K4 students' parents to join with the children in the "Metro" project learning activities. After the ceremony, most of the parents had the chance to participate in the role-playing game with children–collecting money, selling tickets and performing security check. They all enjoyed the game, and were impressed that the children knew very well their responsibilities and division of labour in the game.

The Metro activities have ended, but the children are still enthusiastic about in-depth learning. Through the activities, they have developed the ability to think and problem solving skills. We believe that children will be able to use these experiences in the future.

### 家长读写工作坊

#### Parent Reading and Writing Workshop

我们认为语言教育不只发展幼儿的语言能力,也帮助孩子发展认知、社会情感及相关动作技能。为了让家长不再只着眼于孩子对知识点的掌握,而是更多地注重培养其学习兴趣和品行,我们以绘本《乌鸦喝水》为例,针对语言的综合领域学习特点与孩子的整体和谐发展与家长分享与探讨。有关幼小衔接的问题,我们向家长阐述了以下观点:

- · 学前期过渡至学龄期时,儿童身心变化的核心体现在社会性发展与抽象逻辑思维发展这两方面。
- · 影响学习适应能力和社会性适应能力的因素有: 儿童主动性、家庭因素、课堂中的师幼关系。
- · 使幼儿消极适应一年级的学习生活,会使相当部分儿童 失去在学习中的成功感、自信与学习兴趣,甚至导致厌 学。

活动让家长对儿童的学习特点与方式有了新的认识,他们表示会结合幼儿园的教学方式,修正和反思自己的教育观念。



We believe that literacy education is not limited to the development of children's reading, writing and speaking abilities, but also supports children's development in cognitive, social, emotional and relevant motor skills.

In order to raise parents' awareness of cultivating interest in learning and nurturing good character in children, we used books such as 乌鸦喝水 (The Crow Drinks Water) to discuss the characteristics of the comprehensive study of language and the children's overall balanced development. Regarding the transit from kindergarten to primary, we elaborated on the following views for the parents:

- The social development and abstract logical thinking are the core aspects of change in children when they transit from kindergarten to primary.
- Factors influencing learning and social adaptabilities are: children's initiative, home environment factors, and child-teacher relationships in the classroom.
- Making children adapt passively to the primary school causes them to lose confidence, feeling of success and interest in learning, and even to hate learning.

The workshop gave parents a new understanding of the characteristics and methods of children's learning. They said that they would adopt the teaching methods of the kindergarten, and reflect on their own educational ideas.

People need a leader, even young kindergarten children. Our happy and energetic young children in K5, divided into two classes, have their leader in each class.

Foreign teachers teaching in China need a little help from these little leaders as well. When a child in the class can understand most of the instructions from the foreign teacher and translate simple sentences, it not only helps the teacher, but also helps the entire class.

In K5-1, a young girl named Eva is the class leader. Eva is a kindhearted little girl with an abundance of knowledge for a child of her age. She uses her imagination to dream up stories and games to help other children express their ideas.

In K5-2, a young boy named Stephen is the class leader. Stephen arrives at school very early in the morning, and then interacts with other children to welcome them to the class. Stephen is quiet and generous. He is always willing to help the teachers and other students with a kind heart and a jovial smile.

# 神奇的风 The Magic of Wind

We used postures for strength and flexibility development. Yoga is a deep relaxation and interesting; it is not like gym. Breathing was an important part of that class and the children did it well.

We provided this activity, on one hand, to have fun with the children, and on the other hand to help them know the importance of keeping healthy.

我们持续不断地为幼儿提供不同活动,支持他们在各领域的 发展需要。近期,我们为小班的孩子提供了运动、手工制作 以及感官探索活动。

在多功能厅, James 老师为孩子创设了不同的体能活动站。 孩子需要穿越神秘隧道、爬过大桥、跨过障碍、扔沙包, 最 后把球踢进球门里, 孩子非常喜欢这个活动。我们还一起参 加了接力运球比赛和单脚跳空间赛。活动结束后, 孩子一起 收拾玩具。

Everybody enjoyed going round a number of times to complete the course. Then, we had two races: a ball rolling contest, and a space-hopper race. K3 students made their own colourful gooey slime in Teacher Zach's activity. They mixed all the ingredients – two cups of corn starch, one cup of water and two food colourings – together. When the slime was finished, the children played with it in their hands, to feel it with their fingers, and see how it changed shape.

The students in Teacher Dawn's group made pieces for a large patchwork quilt by tying pieces of colourful material together. A patchwork quilt shows our memories, past experiences and the things we have done together. We then hung the quilt in the campus.
